



## Discipleship Ministries

Children, Youth, Small Groups, Men's and Women's events, and Membership and Baptism classes all fall under the umbrella of Discipleship. Thank you to all those who volunteer and give their time in these vital ministries!

#### Children Highlights: (Marcia DaCosta)

2020 was indeed a "different" kind of year and its impact has definitely been felt within our Children's Ministry. Since the cancellation of in person gathering in March, we have not been able to meet in person with our Kingsview Kids and we miss them dearly. Our main challenge was to ensure that our children remain engaged during this new virtual world.

Each week the lesson and activity were posted on our Facebook page and we encouraged the children and their families engage with the material at home. Also, one of our Teachers, Nancy Brown, engaged the children twice directly in our Facebook Live Sunday Worship Service. Special effort was also made to include the children in some of our services; namely our Mother's Day Service, Father's Day Service and our traditional Christmas program which is usually led by the Kingsview Kids and Youth. The latter was an excellent way to end the year in Children's Ministry. There were many compliments on how wonderful the program was. We are grateful to all the parents or guardians who assisted us in having the videos done for the various services.

As anticipated, however, engagement with the Facebook posts have been low and so as we look ahead, we are working on new ideas to boost engagement. We are also making a deliberate and purposeful attempt to have our children involved in one service per month. We look forward to seeing them involved in this way and look forward to many more connection times with them.

#### Youth Highlights: (April Lansing)

While the Youth Group has continued to meet regularly online during the Pandemic, before in-person events were cancelled in March 2020 we had 2 special events. We had a games night in January where we shared our favorite games (Wii and board games) and snacks. In February several youth and leaders went to Today's Teens Conference at The Meeting House in Oakville, where we always enjoy the variety of workshops and awesome worship.

We have continued to host regular TnT (Truth and Transformation) youth nights, switching from biweekly meetings to weekly in the fall, and on most Sundays, D&D (Donuts and Discussion). We have also had a few special events: in June we ended the school year with an in home scavenger hunt, and in October, we enjoyed a virtual watch party for the live broadcast of the Change Conference.

Many of our youth took up the challenge to memorize verses connected to the commands of Jesus in the spring. This fall we learned about spiritual practices with a series called Sticky Faith by The Fuller Institute.

Though we missed leading the Good Friday Service last year, the youth at Kingsview have remained engaged in Sunday services by helping with announcements, preparing some special music and helping the tech team to prepare the services. The youth do most of the service on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays.

## Missional Resources Team

The Missional Resource Team (MRT) is the ministry group that encompasses KINGSVIEW the former Global Missions Team, the Refugee Sponsorship & Settlement C H U R C H Team, and brings all of our local missional activities under one umbrella.

#### Team:

This past year, Sabrina Hinds, Shawn Bullock, Dean Taylor, Jan Burgess and Pastor J-M comprised the team. The MRT is the group tasked with discerning the direction of our local & global missional activities and creating a ministry plan/strategy for Kingsview regarding:

- Free Methodist missionary support
- local & global para-church partnerships
- congregation-based missional activities

Please pray wisdom for the MRT as we discern a strategy for evaluating new requests for support as well as implement that strategy to keep our congregation connected and informed on all our missionaries and partners.

#### Ministry Highlights:

Tearfund is the FMCiC's official partner for disaster relief and international aid. Our usual Fall Harvest Offering was postponed to allow us to hold that opportunity for generosity when COVID restrictions loosen. Kingsview received a note of thanks from Tearfund for our ongoing support through this difficult season. Kingsview also participated in Operation Christmas Child which is run by Samaritan's Purse. Thank you to Winifred Sookdeo and Jan Burgess for their leadership and coordination in this initiative! 60+ shoeboxes were sent out from Kingsview in December 2020.

As of January 1, 2020, The **Kingsview Sponsorship Program** is now officially a separate charitable entity. Under the leadership of John & Michelle Stewart KSP will continue to engage sponsors for the empowerment of children in the Dominican Republic. KSP will continue to be Kingsview's first recommendation for child sponsorship.

Sam & Jenn Harris had hoped to continue their involvement with Power to Change in their new home in Texas. In addition to that door closing, Jenn received an MS diagnosis in Sept 2020. Jenn is receiving good medical care through Sam's work benefits – an answer to prayer! Pray for continued treatment for Jenn and for the Spirit to draw them into new ministry.

**Refugee Sponsorship** is Kingsview's pilot project in sponsoring the **Sohail family** (Sohail, Sonia, Sarah, Sharoon John) as refugees to Canada. The lawyer that the team hired received notice that their application for leave (a review of the previous denial) and we are waiting for their hearing date. Pray that the Sohails receive a favourable review of their case from the new Canadian judge in Asia. Also pray for their health and perseverance as they wait.

Loreli Cockram is the Young Parents Director with Youth Unlimited in the GTA. Lori sets vision for this ministry, recruits and equips staff and volunteers, and prepares curriculum and resources for six active young parents groups in the GTA. Many Kingsview people participated in the Scotiabank Run Fundraiser which surpassed its goal and raised over \$14 000 for program costs and young parent supports. God has blessed this ministry with exponential growth as programs moved online during COVID (from 25-30 young families in 2019 to 50-60 families in 2020)! Pray for the young parents who are isolated during COVID and for Lori as she continues to raise her personal support and recruit new staff for key positions.

Summer 2020 allowed for 2 youth to be hired through the Canada Summer Jobs program to work with our partners in Dixon Ministries which welcomes newcomers to Canada. Krista Hinds and Rebecca Bruce did an amazing job as online coordinators and ESL teachers/coaches! Pray for this summer's opportunities and the students who will be hired.

Dixon Ministries ESL program that usually meets in the Broadview Education wing of our building Monday to Thursday each week, successfully pivoted to online programming as the COVID restrictions prevented in-person class gatherings. Pray for this vital ministry to newcomers to Canada that provides practical skills and a clear demonstration of Jesus' love through churches working together in the community.

Pastor J-M has also been building bridges to the community by attending and supporting the **Etobicoke Strategy** which is a partnership of local churches whose purpose is to address and respond to gun violence in the community. Prince Gbeklui is Kingsview's representative on the **Community Police Liaison Committee** (CPLC). In the fall, a connection was made through Aart Van Eywk to **The Neighbourhood Table** program headed by St. Philip's Lutheran Church in Etobicoke. This existing program is expanding its reach to help provide food security for seniors and families in our local area. Several families benefitted from the program in the winter session 2021. Pray that these connections yield new local opportunities and spread the *shalom* of Jesus in our neighbourhood.

- welcoming the Sohails to Canada!
- increasing involvement of Kingview members in activities in our neighbourhood & beyond
- assigning a layperson to be a "champion" for each missionary or partner organization
- completing a missions strategy/policy

- expand/identify local needs to build bridges in our community
- hiring 4 summer students through the Canada Summer Jobs program
- continuing to work together with Dixon ESL and further develop connections with The Neighbourhood Table program
