



Series—Abraham and Sarah



As we enter a new ministry season at Kingsview, we're also celebrating our 60th Anniversary—looking back over our history in gratitude, looking at the steps of faith we need to take today, and looking forward with anticipation to what God will do in the future.

Similarly, our fall sermon series is focused on the life story of Abraham and Sarah. Studying their lives helps give us a great perspective on faith. It's a story of gradual transformation by divine grace. At 75 years old, Abram leaves his country, his community

and his own parents to follow God's call. Later, Abram and Sarai become Abraham and Sarah, at 100 and 90, re-

spectively and they realize a long-awaited promise; they have a son, named Isaac. They make important decisions of faith, but the life of faith is shown to include prolonged struggles with sin and its consequences, many faults and lapses of judgement. Maturity is reached slowly (Abraham lives to 175 years old)!

The point is made clear in both the Old and the New Testaments; each time Abraham is referred to as a great example of trusting God—Abraham and Sarah believed

God's promises. Both are portrayed as the father and mother of faith.

This is what the writer of Hebrews alludes to in 11:8, 11-12. Abraham and Sarah are famous, just as God promised, because they believed the Lord, and he declared them righteous considering their faith.

As we'll explore in the coming weeks, their righteousness was not because they never sinned -- rather, it was because they consistently returned to God. I hope you'll dig into God's word with us each week, and come to a deeper understanding and experience of faith by looking at the ancient example of Abraham and Sarah, so that we, too, will establish faith in the Lord as our guiding principle in life.
